GENERAL BUSINESS:

SNZ transfers & affiliation fees review.

Meeting felt Canterbury transfer system works well with clubs agreeing to release and accept both included on form & being actioned by the Administrator & ratified later at committee level, However the need for clarity surrounding transfers after meets entries have been lodged & meet date needs clarifying. Suggestion to have a 6 week unattached phase would solve this problem.

Canterbury region are presently working on a new strategic plan and the issue of level of affiliations is involved in this process. One issue is the possibility of new members having a lower level of free entry for a couple of years or alternatively seeing more for the affiliations they do pay at the beginner stage. B Naylor & M Morrison both highlighted the problem of getting learn to swim to take the next step to competition & the financial outlay being a deterrent.

SICC – review by Mike Schout of AGM – This was a very successful and positive meeting with all regions coming to unanimous agreement on the need to change the present Country Clubs system and move on to the plan proposed by Southland.

Cheque from Papauni \$7502.92 this is the final payment of the Papanui club funds. CWCS will pay the Auditor from these funds for the final audit. The money is to be invested at present in #2 investment account until a target use can be identified. Carey to write to SNZ formally asking for dissolution of the Papanui Swimming Club.

A Query as to the reason Southland region swim sometimes as individual clubs and sometimes as a region Carey to ask SNZ for clarification.
